Notice of Race

Autumn Regatta 2016 and the Kestrel Open 2016

Friday 7th October 2016 through Sunday 9th October 2016

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013–2016*. The organising authority is the Paphos International Sailing Club.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Racing rules may be changed as follows: 29, 33, 35, A4, A5, 60.1(a), 61.1(a)(2), 62.1(a). The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 Advertising

- 1.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

2 Venue

- 2.1 Agios Georgios harbour, Pegeia, Paphos, Cyprus.

3 Series and Classes

- 3.1 The regatta consists of two series; the PISC Autumn Regatta 2016 and the Kestrel Open 2016.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to members of the Paphos International Sailing Club and/or the Kestrel Class Association of the United Kingdom.

5 Registration

- 5.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the form in Attachment A and presenting it, together with the required fee, at the registration desk during the times allowed for registration in section 8. The registration desk will be located by the café at Agios Georgios beach.
- 5.2 Competitors are asked to aid the organising authority by advising of their intention to register via email to ViceCommodore@pisc.com.cy.

6 Fees

- 6.1 The required registration fee per boat is:
 - PISC Autumn Regatta 2016: €25
 - Kestrel Open 2016: €35

7 Classes

- 7.1 The Kestrel Open series will be open to all Kestrel class boats from Mark 1 through to 2000.
- 7.2 The Autumn Regatta series will be held for a General Handicap class and a Wayfarer one design class. If there are less than five (5) boats entered in the General Handicap class, all boats entered in the series will start together.

8 Schedule

- 8.1 *Friday October 7th 2016*

 - 8.1.2 Briefing: 1100
 - 8.1.3 Kestrel Open: Maximum of two (2) races back to back. First warning signal 1230
 - 8.1.4 Clubhouse dinner 1900
- 8.2 *Saturday October 8th 2016*
 - 8.2.1 Registration: 0930 to 1100
 - 8.2.2 Regatta Briefing: 1100
 - 8.2.3 Autumn Regatta and Kestrel Open: Maximum of two (2) races back to back. First warning signal 1230
 - 8.2.4 Regatta BBQ 1900
- 8.3 *Sunday October 9th 2016*
 - 8.3.1 Regatta Briefing: 1100
 - 8.3.2 Autumn Regatta and Kestrel Open: Maximum of two (2) races back to back: First warning signal 1230
 - 8.3.3 Prize giving: as soon as reasonably possible following the last race of the series
- 8.4 The Sailing Instructions may change the regatta schedule.

9 Sailing Instructions

- 9.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration, and may also be posted prior to the regatta at www.pisc.com.cy/on-the-water/regatta-information.

10 Scoring

- 10.1 Two (2) races will be required to constitute a series in each of the Autumn Regatta and Kestrel Open.
- 10.2 The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be a total of her race scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed.
- 10.3 Where multiple classes are competing against each other, the most recent Portsmouth Yardstick rating published by the Royal Yachting Association will be used.

11 Prizes

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to helm & crew to third place in each class in each series.
- 11.2 The Organising Authority may award other trophies at its own discretion.
- 11.3 The Peter Dicker Memorial Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the top boat in the overall regatta, across both series, which is helmed by a full PISC member (not temporary). Eligible boats will be scored against each other using their relevant rating for all races where all classes competed and sailed the same course.

12 Berthing of dinghies

- 12.1 Dinghies shall keep to their allocated places when ashore as directed by the Beach Master.

Dinghy trolleys must be tagged with a sail number and other identifying information.

13 Disclaimer of Liability

- 13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Paphos International Sailing Club, its officers, volunteers or agents will not accept any liability for any damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Participants agree that no person or organization involved in the conduct of the regatta will be liable for any accident, injury, fatality, or damage or loss of boat or personal property arising out of a participant's preparation for or participation in any on-the-water or on-shore activities (whether social, recreational, launching, hauling, boat storage or otherwise) associated with the regatta.

14 Insurance

- 14.1 Each participating boat must carry valid third party indemnity insurance.
